

* National Day of Romania

On **December 1, 1918**, the National Assembly of Romanians was convened in Alba Iulia, the works ending with the Decision of unconditional union of Transylvania with Romania, voted unanimously. This act took place after, on March 27, 1918 and November 28, 1918, respectively, the representative bodies of Bessarabia and Bukovina voted for the union.

On December 1, 1918, it was decided unanimously to unite Transylvania, Crișana and Maramureș with Romania, but maintaining a local autonomy, on a democratic basis, with equality between nationalities and religions.

* How National Day is celebrated on December 1st

- * A big parade with soldiers is being prepared for the day of December 1, which takes place in the capital of Romania (Bucharest) with the participation of specialists from the **Ministry of National Defense, MAI, SRI, STS and the National Administration of Penitentiaries**. They do both a ground and an air show. They are presented armored combat as well as airplanes and helicopters.
